

SENATE BILL 730

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57,
relative to alcoholic beverages.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-103(a), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

() If any municipality located in any county having a population of not less than eight hundred ninety thousand (890,000) nor more than nine hundred thousand (900,000), according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census, has authorized the sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises in a referendum in the manner prescribed by § 57-3-106, then the unincorporated areas of the county shall be authorized for the sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises without having to hold a separate referendum in the manner prescribed by § 57-3-106. This subdivision shall not apply to any county that has a metropolitan form of government.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
