SENATE BILL 905

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 68, Chapter 212, relative to fentanyl.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE: SECTION 1.

- (a) The Tennessee advisory commission on intergovernmental relations (TACIR) is directed to perform a study and make recommendations regarding the inspection, testing, and quarantine of property where fentanyl or its analogues are found in this state.
- (b) All appropriate state department and agencies shall provide assistance to TACIR in connection with the study required by subsection (a).
- (c) On or before January 1, 2020, TACIR shall report its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, regarding fentanyl to the members of the health committees of the house of representatives and senate.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring

it.
