

SENATE BILL 929

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 47,
Chapter 18, relative to consumer protection.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 47-18-103, is amended by adding the following language as new, appropriately designated subdivisions:

() "Radio frequency identification" or "RFID" means technologies that use radio waves to automatically identify individual items;

() "Tag" means a microchip that is attached to an antenna and is able to transmit identification information;

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 47-18-104(b), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

() Selling any consumer item containing a radio frequency identification tag.

Provided, radio frequency identification tags may be used solely to deter theft of the consumer item and must be removed upon purchase of the item;

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013, the public welfare requiring it.
