

SENATE BILL 931

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4;
Title 7; Title 8; Title 9; Title 38; Title 39 and Title
40, relative to immigration.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-42-103, is amended by designating the existing language as subsection (a) and adding the following new subsection (b)

(b) Subsection (a) does not apply to:

- (1) The department of education;
- (2) The Tennessee higher education commission;
- (3) The Tennessee board of regents;
- (4) The department of children's services;
- (5) The department of health;
- (6) The department of human services; or
- (7) State law enforcement agencies when working with victims of a criminal offense, witnesses of a criminal offense, or individuals reporting a criminal offense.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 7-68-103, is amended by designating the existing language as subsection (a) and adding the following new subsection (b):

(b) Subsection (a) does not apply to:

- (1) School districts or open-enrollment charter schools;
- (2) Publicly owned hospitals;
- (3) Local and regional health departments; or

(4) Law enforcement agencies when working with victims of a criminal offense, witnesses of a criminal offense, or individuals reporting a criminal offense.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
