

SENATE BILL 937

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2,
Chapter 3, Part 1, relative to polling places.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-3-107(b)(1), is amended by adding the following new subdivision:

(C)

(i) County election commissions shall give publicly owned buildings priority as a voting location during the early voting period and on election day.

(ii) A political organization or individual shall not hold a political event, fundraiser, or rally during early voting or on election day at any location on the premises of public or private property for which any part of such property is used as a polling place, regardless of the distance of the event, fundraiser, or rally from the polling place.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
