

SENATE BILL 999

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2;
Title 4; Title 8; Title 69 and Title 70, relative to the
Tennessee fish and wildlife commission.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-1-206(a)(7), is amended by
deleting the language:

Further, the commission shall report actions taken on permits, licenses, and fees to be
assessed following the promulgation of the proposed rules and regulations to the
energy, agriculture and natural resources committee of the senate and to the agriculture
and natural resources committee of the house of representatives.

and substituting instead the language:

Further, the commission shall report actions taken on permits, licenses, and fees to be
assessed following the promulgation of the proposed rules to the energy, agriculture and
natural resources committee of the senate, the agriculture and natural resources
committee of the house of representatives, the judiciary committee of the senate, and
the criminal justice committee of the house of representatives.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
