

SENATE BILL 1099

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 70,  
relative to wildlife resources.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-5-101(f), is amended by deleting subdivision (6) in its entirety and by substituting instead the following language:

(6) Prior to January 1, 2008, and each January 1 thereafter, the agency shall post on its web site and submit to the chair of the agriculture and natural resources committee of the house of representatives and the chair of the energy, agriculture and natural resources committee of the senate a written report containing:

(A) The estimated acreage managed by the agency that has been closed to recreational hunting and fishing during the previous fiscal year and the reasons for the closures;

(B) The estimated acreage managed by the agency that was opened to recreational hunting and fishing to compensate for the estimated acreage that was closed during the previous fiscal year; and

(C) The estimated acreage of new public hunting and fishing lands added to the existing hunting and fishing lands base since the previous report.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
