AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39, Chapter 15, Part 5, relative to crimes against elderly and vulnerable adults.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-15-506(a)(1), is amended by deleting the language:

notify the department of health of the conviction by sending a copy of the judgment

and substituting the language:

notify the health facilities commission, created by § 68-11-1604, of the conviction within ninety (90) calendar days of the date of the conviction by sending a copy of the judgment

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-15-506(a), is amended by deleting the word "department" in subdivisions (a)(2) and (3), and substituting the word "commission".

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-15-506(a)(3), is amended by deleting the language "commissioner, or the commissioner's designee" and substituting the language "executive director of the health facilities commission, or the executive director's designee".

SECTION 4. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
