

SENATE BILL 1367

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 5;
Title 6; Title 7; Title 13; Title 62; Title 67 and Title
68, relative to the regulation of swingers clubs.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1.

(a) The department of commerce and insurance shall study the status of swingers clubs as a regulated form of operation in this state.

(b) The department of revenue and the department of health shall provide assistance to the department of commerce and insurance in conducting the study required by subsection (a).

(c) The study shall focus on, but not be limited to, the following:

(1) Any activities or accommodations that are uniquely provided by swingers clubs that would assist the general assembly in determining how to define swingers clubs;

(2) Whether swingers clubs pose any threat to public health and safety;

and

(3) The amount of revenue that would be required to administer the regulation of swingers clubs in this state.

(d) The department of commerce and insurance shall report their findings together with any recommendations for legislation to the general assembly by December 1, 2015.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring

it.
