

SENATE BILL 1422

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 40,
Chapter 32, Part 1, relative to the destruction of
certain criminal records.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-32-101, is amended by adding
the following new (a)(1)(A)(v):

(v)

(a) The person plead guilty or was found guilty of a misdemeanor offense
and such conviction was the person's first criminal conviction, the person's
sentence was suspended and the person was placed on probation, the person
complied with all conditions of probation, and the person has not been convicted
of any other criminal offense for a period of three (3) years from the date the
person was released from probation supervision;

(b) A person applying to a court after July 1, 2011, for the expunction of
the person's records following the successful completion of a probation program
as authorized by this subdivision shall be charged the appropriate court clerk's
fee pursuant to § 8-21-401 for destroying such records.

SECTION 2 . This act shall take effect July 1, 2011, the public welfare requiring it and
shall apply to any person committing an applicable offense on or after such date.
