AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, relative to temporary plates.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:


SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-17-114(b)(1), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

Fails to maintain a record of a customer's motor vehicle liability insurance coverage or other proof of financial responsibility for any customer who is issued a temporary plate by a motor vehicle dealer who finances the sale of used motor vehicles and retains the title to such vehicles. The record shall be maintained in the same manner or for the same period of time as the record of issuance of temporary plates described in subdivision (b)(1)(N);

SECTION 2. For the purposes of promulgating rules or forms, including electronic forms, this act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, this act shall take effect January 1, 2019, the public welfare requiring it.


