HOUSE BILL NO. 1605

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 7, Chapter 35, relative to sewer systems in a city having a population of not less than five hundred thirty (530) nor more than five hundred forty (540) that is located in a county having a population of not less than thirty-one thousand seven hundred one (31,701) nor more than thirty-one thousand eight hundred seven (31,807), according to the 2010 federal census or any subsequent federal census.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 7-35-202, is amended by deleting the following language from the first sentence:

having a population of not less than eight hundred ninety (890) nor more than nine hundred (900), according to the 1990 federal census or any subsequent federal census,

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 7-35-202, is further amended by designating the existing language as subsection (a) and adding the following language as a new subsection (b):

(b) As used in this section, "municipality" means a municipality having a population of:

(1) Not less than eight hundred ninety (890) nor more than nine hundred (900), according to the 1990 federal census or any subsequent federal census; and

(2) Not less than five hundred thirty (530) nor more than five hundred forty (540) that is located in a county having a population of not less than thirty-one thousand seven hundred one (31,701) nor more than thirty-one thousand eight hundred seven (31,807), according to the 2010 federal census or any subsequent federal census.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. This act applies only to fees, assessments, and charges that become due and owing on or after the effective date of this act.


