## PRIVATE CHAPTER NO. 40

HOUSE BILL NO. 1709

AN ACT to amend Chapter 153 of the Private Acts of 1917; as amended by Chapter 53 of the Private Acts of 1995; Chapter 54 of the Private Acts of 2001; Chapter 118 of the Private Acts of 2006 and Chapter 5 of the Private Acts of 2015; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to revising the tax rate in the Bradford Special School District.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 153 of the Private Acts of 1917, as amended by Chapter 53 of the Private Acts of 1995, Chapter 54 of the Private Acts of 2001, Chapter 118 of the Private Acts of 2006, Chapter 5 of the Private Acts of 2015, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is hereby further amended by deleting the following:

Effective July 1, 2015, and for the fiscal year beginning thereon, there is hereby levied a property tax of one dollar eighty-two cents (\$1.82) on every one hundred dollars (\$100) of real and personal property located within the Bradford Special School District.

and substituting instead the following:

Effective July 1, 2022, and for the fiscal year beginning thereon, there is hereby levied a property tax of one dollar ninety-eight cents (\$1.98) on every one hundred dollars (\$100) of real and personal property located within the Bradford Special School District.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
