

SENATE BILL 1784

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4,  
Chapter 1, Part 3, relative to the state fife and  
drum corp..

WHEREAS, the Watauga Valley Fife and Drum Corps provides education as well as entertainment through reenactments and performances at state historic areas throughout this state; and

WHEREAS, the Watauga Valley Fife and Drum Corps, as the only active fife and drum corps in this state, is a vitally important part of the preservation of the state's heritage; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly wishes to recognize the significant contributions to the rich culture and historical preservation of this state through the exceptional efforts of the Watauga Valley Fife and Drum Corps; now, therefore,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 1, Part 3, is amended by adding the following as a new appropriately designated section:

The Watauga Valley Fife and Drum Corps is hereby designated as the official state fife and drum corps.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
