

SENATE BILL 2149

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55,
relative to driver license suspension, revocation, or
cancellation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, Chapter 50, Part 5, is amended by adding the following new section:

Any county or city may, by resolution or ordinance, establish a program that allows any person who is indigent and who has been convicted of driving while the person's license is cancelled, suspended, or revoked in violation of § 55-50-504(a) to complete community service work in lieu of paying the fines and other costs imposed for the conviction.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
