SENATE BILL 2163

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 12-2-117, relative to unused department property.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 12-2-117(b)(2), is amended by deleting the language "planning and construction of mental health facilities as well as for the transition of patients from an institutional setting into community programs" and substituting instead "capital maintenance for property controlled by the department of mental health and substance abuse services".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 12-2-117(b), is amended by deleting subdivisions (3)-(5).

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 12-2-117(e)(3), is amended by deleting the language "planning and developing intellectual disability programs for persons with intellectual disabilities as defined in § 33-1-101, including, but not limited to, the transition of persons from an institutional setting into community services, start-up funding for individuals and agencies, and the purchase of homes" and substituting instead "capital maintenance for property controlled by the department of intellectual and developmental disabilities".

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020, the public welfare requiring it.
