

SENATE BILL 2163

AN ACT to amend Chapter 754 of the Private Acts of 1947; and any other acts amendatory thereto relative to the city of Shelbyville.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 754 of the Private Acts of 1947 and any other act amendatory thereto, is amended by deleting in Article III, Section 14 the language "a majority vote of those present shall be necessary for affirmative or negative action by the Council." and substituting instead the language "a majority of those present and voting shall be necessary for affirmative or negative action by the Council including the election of members of the Electric Power, Water and Sewerage Board created in Chapter 465 of the Private Acts of 1939, as amended by Chapter 293 of the Private Acts of 1941, as amended by Chapter 421 of the Private Acts of 1953, as amended by Chapter 202 of the Private Acts of 1957, as amended by Chapter 277 of the Private Acts of 1965, as amended by Chapter 66 of the Private Acts of 1977; and any other acts amendatory thereto."

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of Shelbyville. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of Shelbyville and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective as provided in Section 2.
