AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 40, relative to parole determinations.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. This act is known and may be cited as the "Joe Clyde Daniels Act."

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-35-503(g), is amended by redesignating the current subsection as subdivision (g)(1) and adding the following new subdivision:

(2) In cases in which the offender was convicted of a homicide, the board shall also consider as a factor the extent to which the offender obstructed or continues to obstruct the ability of law enforcement to recover the remains of the victim.

SECTION 3. This act takes effect July 1, 2022, the public welfare requiring it.
