

SENATE BILL 2293

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 62,  
Chapter 3 and Title 62, Chapter 4, relative to  
professions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-3-110(a)(3), is amended by deleting subdivision (B).

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-3-110(b), is amended by deleting subdivision (2).

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-3-124(a)(1), is amended by deleting subdivision (B) and substituting instead the following:

    Holds a valid certificate of registration as a master barber and has been duly registered as a master barber for a period of at least three (3) years prior to filing an application to be an instructor;

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-3-124(a), is amended by deleting subdivisions (1)(C) and (2)(C).

SECTION 5. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-3-124(d)(1), is amended by deleting subdivision (C).

SECTION 6. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-4-110(c)(2), is amended by deleting subdivision (A).

SECTION 7. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-4-110(c)(2), is amended by deleting subdivision (D) and substituting instead the following:

    Has been licensed as a cosmetologist, aesthetician, manicurist, or natural hair stylist pursuant to this chapter for at least three (3) years; and

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018, the public welfare requiring it.
