

SENATE BILL 2395

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55,
Chapter 10, Part 4, relative to litter removal.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-10-402(a)(1), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision:

(C) In addition to any mandatory minimum sentence ordered pursuant to this subdivision (a)(1), a person violating § 55-10-401, upon conviction for the first offense, shall remove litter as a condition of probation during the daylight hours from public roadways or publicly owned property for a period of twenty-four (24) hours in three (3) shifts of eight (8) consecutive hours each; provided, that litter removal as a condition of probation shall be ordered only if the county where the person is convicted has had a litter and trash removal program for such offenders in operation since July 1, 2016.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018, the public welfare requiring it.
