SENATE BILL 2487

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 62, Chapter 4, relative to certain cosmetology services offered outside a shop.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-4-125, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

(f)

- (1) Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter to the contrary, a licensed cosmetologist may style hair or apply makeup at a location outside a shop or school if the:
 - (A) Licensed cosmetologist is not cutting or washing hair; and
 - (B) Location in which the cosmetologist is styling hair or applying makeup is not a location open to the general public but is only available for styling hair and applying makeup through a private rental agreement.
 - (2) For purposes of this subsection (f):
 - (A) "Private rental agreement" means a written agreement signed by the person, or person's representative, for whom the cosmetologist services described in this subsection (f) will be performed that sets out the terms of the rental agreement and provides notice that the location in which services are being provided are not under the supervision of the board of cosmetology; and
 - (B) "Style hair" or "styling hair" means arranging, dressing, curling or waving hair, but does not include cutting or washing hair.

	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring
it.
