

SENATE BILL 2828

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, Chapter 21, Part 1 and Title 55, Chapter 4, relative to registration plates issued for persons with disabilities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-4-103(b)(5)(A), is amended by deleting the language "pursuant to this section" and substituting instead the language "pursuant to this section or § 55-21-103".

SECTION 2. Registration plates for private passenger motor vehicles issued pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-21-103, must be issued containing the national motto language as described in Section 1 of this act upon the depletion of the existing inventory being utilized by the department of revenue. The commissioner of revenue shall ensure that a sufficient number of registration plates issued pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-21-103, without the national motto language are available to be issued in addition to those with the language.

SECTION 3. This act takes effect January 1, 2025, the public welfare requiring it.
