AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 70, relative to hunting where bait is present.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-4-113, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection (c) and redesignating the existing subsection (c) accordingly:

- (c) It is not a violation of subsection (a) for a person to hunt on or over land where bait is present, if:
 - (1) The bait was present on the land for any amount of time immediately preceding the person commencing hunting; and
 - (2) The land is not posted pursuant to § 70-4-128.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
