

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 117

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Stefan Maupin to the advisory board for the University of Tennessee at Martin.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-9-501, established an advisory board for the University of Tennessee at Martin; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-9-501, provides that the governor shall appoint five members to such advisory board; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Lee has appointed Stefan Maupin to the advisory board for the University of Tennessee at Martin for a term that expires on June 30, 2028; and

WHEREAS, Stefan Maupin serves as the executive director of the Tennessee Soybean Promotion Council, where he is responsible for assisting the council in managing the investment of soy checkoff dollars that are used to fund soybean research, market development, and education; and

WHEREAS, a graduate of the University of Tennessee at Martin, Mr. Maupin worked for the Tennessee Farm Bureau Federation for twenty-seven years, serving as the director of the public policy division for the last eleven of those years; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-9-501, provides that each member appointed by the governor to the advisory board for the University of Tennessee at Martin shall be confirmed by the general assembly; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FOURTEENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, that we hereby confirm the appointment of Stefan

Maupin to the advisory board for the University of Tennessee at Martin for a term that expires on June 30, 2028.
