

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 217

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Linda Moss Mines to the standards recommendation committee for science and social studies.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-313, creates a standards recommendation committee for science and social studies; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-312(a), provides that the governor shall appoint four members to the standards recommendation committee for science and social studies; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Lee has appointed Linda Moss Mines to serve on such committee for a term that expires on January 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Linda Moss Mines is a retired historian, educator, and community volunteer who taught for forty-five years, including twenty-seven years as chair of the History Department at Girls Preparatory School in Chattanooga; and

WHEREAS, the official Chattanooga and Hamilton County historian, Dr. Mines received her Bachelor of Science and Master of Arts degrees from Tennessee Technological University and her Doctor of Education degree from the University of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-312(b), provides that all appointments to the committee "shall be subject to confirmation by the senate and the house of representatives"; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRTEENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, that we confirm the appointment of Linda Moss Mines to

the standards recommendation committee for science and social studies for a term that expires on January 31, 2024.
