

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 827

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Krissi McInturff of Jonesborough to the State Board of Education.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-301, provides for the creation of the State Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-301(a)(3)(iii), provides that the governor shall appoint three members to the State Board of Education representing the 1st, 5th, and 9th congressional districts; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Lee has appointed Krissi McInturff of Jonesborough to the State Board of Education for a term that will expire on March 31, 2028, as a member representing the 1st Congressional District; and

WHEREAS, a highly respected member of her community, Krissi McInturff has been a public school teacher in Tennessee for fifteen years and has taught third grade, first grade, RTI, and fourth-grade ELA and social studies; and

WHEREAS, Ms. McInturff holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Early Childhood Development and a Master of Education degree in Elementary Education from Milligan University. She is currently pursuing a Doctor of Philosophy degree in History from Liberty University; and

WHEREAS, Krissi McInturff is a person of integrity and an active citizen whose benevolence, acumen, and strong commitment to public service have helped to enhance the well-being of this State and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-301, provides that each member appointed by the governor to the State Board of Education shall be confirmed by joint resolution of the General Assembly; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRTEENTH
GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF
REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, that this body does hereby confirm the appointment of
Krissi McInturff to the State Board of Education for a term that will expire on March 31, 2028.
