WHEREAS, not an on-air personality herself, Susie credits her wonderful staff and crew for their dedication to making the station a success by filling a need in Wilson County with their efforts; and

WHEREAS, a native of Lebanon, Susie attended McClain Elementary School and Friendship Christian School. She took classes at Cumberland University and is a graduate of Middle Tennessee State University; and

WHEREAS, Susie enjoys the love and support of her husband, Ed James; her two children and their spouses, Christopher Bay and Trish White and Chelsea Bay and Greg Nyce; and her grandchild, Gordon Nyce; and

WHEREAS, an active member of her community, Mrs. James is a graduate of Leadership Wilson and a member of College Hills Church of Christ and the Kiwanis Club of Lebanon; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. James epitomizes the spirit and commitment that are characteristic of a true Tennessean; and

WHEREAS, as an accomplished member of her profession and a respected leader in her community, Susie James is a Tennessean of whom we can all be proud, and it is highly appropriate that the members of this legislative body recognize such an esteemed legend of radio broadcasting; now, therefore,
