

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 957

WHEREAS, in 1979, he was first in his class as a graduate of the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center; and

WHEREAS, throughout his estimable career, Mr. Weaver has demonstrated the utmost professionalism, ability, and integrity, winning the unbridled respect and admiration of his colleagues and the members and staff of the General Assembly; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED TWELFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, that we extend to Roberts V. Weaver, Jr., our heartfelt wishes for a happy and fulfilling retirement and every continued success in his future endeavors.
