A BILL

To appropriate certain amounts to provide assistance under the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act in response to Hurricane Helene, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Americans First Dis-
5 aster Relief Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR DISASTER**
2 **RELIEF RELATED TO HURRICANE HELENE.**

3 In addition to amounts otherwise available, there is
4 appropriated, out of any money in the Treasury not other-
5 wise appropriated, \$10,000,000,000 to the Administrator
6 of the Federal Emergency Management Agency to provide
7 assistance under the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief
8 and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5121 et seq.)
9 in response to Hurricane Helene.

10 **SEC. 3. RESCISSION OF CERTAIN BALANCES MADE AVAIL-**
11 **ABLE FOR THE INTERNAL REVENUE SERV-**
12 **ICE.**

13 Of the unobligated balances of amounts appropriated
14 or otherwise made available for activities of the Internal
15 Revenue Service by paragraphs (1)(A)(iii), (1)(B), (2),
16 (3), (4), and (5) of section 10301 of Public Law 117–
17 169 (commonly known as the “Inflation Reduction Act of
18 2022”) as of the date of the enactment of this Act,
19 \$10,000,000,000 are hereby rescinded.

20 **SEC. 4. PROHIBITION OF FUNDS.**

21 None of the funds made available by this Act may
22 be used to provide any benefit (including the provision of
23 food, shelter, healthcare services, legal services, and trans-
24 portation) to any alien who is present in the United States
25 without lawful status under the immigration laws (as such

1 terms are defined in section 101 of the Immigration and
2 Nationality Act).
