## A BILL

To prohibit an entity from receiving Federal funds if such entity provides to any person any medical or surgical intervention for the purpose of assisting an individual's disassociation from his or her sex.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Stopping the Mutila-  
5 tion of Children Act of 2024".

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-  
8 sion of law, no Federal funds may be provided, directly

1 or indirectly, to an entity which provides to any person  
2 any medical or surgical intervention for the purpose of as-  
3 sisting an individual's disassociation from his or her sex.

4 (b) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this Act  
5 shall be construed to prohibit funding to entities which  
6 provide medical or surgical intervention in response to a  
7 developmental or genetic anomaly or historical accident.

8 **SEC. 3. DEFINITIONS.**

9 In this Act:

10 (1) FEMALE.—The term “female” refers to an  
11 individual who has, had, will have, or would have,  
12 but for a developmental or genetic anomaly or his-  
13 torical accident, the reproductive system that at  
14 some point produces, transports, and utilizes eggs  
15 for fertilization.

16 (2) MALE.—The term “male” refers to an indi-  
17 vidual who has, had, will have, or would have, but  
18 for a developmental or genetic anomaly or historical  
19 accident, the reproductive system that at some point  
20 produces, transports, and utilizes sperm for fertiliza-  
21 tion.

22 (3) SEX.—The term “sex” refers to biological  
23 sex, either male or female.
