A BILL

To exclude the imposition of duties and import quotas from the authorities provided to the President under the International Emergency Economic Powers Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Prevent Tariff Abuse
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON THE IMPOSITION OF IMPORT DU-**
2 **TIES AND QUOTAS FROM PRESIDENTIAL AU-**
3 **THORITIES UNDER THE INTERNATIONAL**
4 **EMERGENCY ECONOMIC POWERS ACT.**

5 Section 203 of the International Emergency Eco-
6 nomic Powers Act (50 U.S.C. 1702) is amended—

7 (1) by redesignating subsection (c) as sub-
8 section (d); and

9 (2) by inserting after subsection (b) the fol-
10 lowing:

11 “(c) The authority granted to the President by this
12 section does not include the authority to impose duties,
13 tariff-rate quotas, or other quotas on articles entering the
14 United States.”.
