3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Occupational Therapy
5 in Mental Health Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCLUDING OCCUPATIONAL THERAPISTS AS BE-**
2 **HAVIORAL AND MENTAL HEALTH PROFES-**
3 **SIONALS FOR PURPOSES OF THE NATIONAL**
4 **HEALTH SERVICE CORPS.**

5 Section 331(a)(1)(E)(i) of the Public Health Service
6 Act (42 U.S.C. 254d(a)(1)(E)(i)) is amended by inserting
7 “occupational therapists,” after “psychiatric nurse spe-
8 cialists,”.

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
