A BILL

To require the Secretary of Agriculture to use negotiated rulemaking to develop a rule about agriculture quarantine inspection, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Fair and Transparent
5 Stakeholder Involvement Fee Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REVISED RULEMAKING AUTHORITY WITH RESPECT**
7 **TO AGRICULTURE QUARANTINE INSPECTION.**

8 (a) ANNUL EXISTING REGULATIONS.—The Secretary
9 of Agriculture may not issue a final rule based on the pro-
10 posed rule entitled “User Fees for Agricultural Quar-

1 antine and Inspection Services” (79 Fed. Reg. 22895;
2 April 25, 2014) and if such final rule is issued before the
3 date of the enactment of this Act, the final rule shall have
4 no force or effect.

5 (b) RESTRICTIONS ON RULEMAKING AUTHORITY.—
6 The Secretary of Agriculture may not issue a final rule
7 pursuant to section 2509(a) of the Food, Agriculture,
8 Conservation, and Trade (FACT) Act of 1990 (21 U.S.C.
9 136a(a)) except in compliance with the procedures de-
10 scribed in subchapter III of chapter 5 of title 5, United
11 States Code.

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
