## A BILL

To authorize the President to enter into negotiations to acquire Greenland and to rename Greenland as “Red, White, and Blueland”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Red, White, and  
5 Blueland Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. PURCHASE OR OTHER ACQUISITION OF GREEN-**  
2 **LAND.**

3 The President is authorized to enter into negotiations  
4 with the Government of Denmark to purchase or otherwise  
5 acquire Greenland.

6 **SEC. 3. RENAMING OF GREENLAND AS “RED, WHITE, AND**  
7 **BLUELAND”.**

8 (a) **RENAMING.**—Greenland shall be known as “Red,  
9 White, and Blueland”.

10 (b) **REFERENCES.**—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
11 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
12 States to Greenland shall be deemed to be a reference to  
13 “Red, White, and Blueland”.

14 (c) **IMPLEMENTATION.**—

15 (1) **IN GENERAL.**—The Secretary of the Inte-  
16 rior, acting through the Chairman of the Board on  
17 Geographic Names, shall oversee the implementation  
18 of the renaming described in subsection (a) with re-  
19 spect to each Federal document and map.

20 (2) **REQUIREMENT.**—Not later than 180 days  
21 after the date of the enactment of this section, the  
22 head of each Federal agency shall update each docu-  
23 ment and map of the Federal agency in accordance  
24 with the renaming described in subsection (a).
