A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to increase the maximum contribution limit for health savings accounts.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Health Savings Ac-
5 count Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. MAXIMUM CONTRIBUTION LIMIT TO HSA IN-**
7 **CREASED TO AMOUNT OF DEDUCTIBLE AND**
8 **OUT-OF-POCKET LIMITATION.**

9 (a) SELF-ONLY COVERAGE.—Section 223(b)(2)(A)
10 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by strik-

1 ing “\$2,250” and inserting “the amount in effect under
2 subsection (c)(2)(A)(ii)(I)”.

3 (b) FAMILY COVERAGE.—Section 223(b)(2)(B) of
4 such Code is amended by striking “\$4,500” and inserting
5 “the amount in effect under subsection (c)(2)(A)(ii)(II)”.

6 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
7 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after
8 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
