3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “MSPB Temporary
5 Term Extension Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. MERIT SYSTEMS PROTECTION BOARD MEMBERS:**
2 **TERM EXTENSION AND LIMITATION ON SERV-**
3 **ICE.**

4 (a) **EXTENSION OF TERM.**—The term of office of any
5 member of the Merit Systems Protection Board appointed
6 under section 1202 of title 5, United States Code, serving
7 as such a member on the date of enactment of this Act
8 shall be extended for a period of one year beyond the date
9 the member’s service would otherwise end under sub-
10 section (c) of such section.

11 (b) **LIMITATION ON HOLDING FEDERAL POSITIONS**
12 **CONCURRENTLY.**—Notwithstanding section 1201 of title
13 5, United States Code, any member of the Merit Systems
14 Protection Board whose term is extended by subsection
15 (a) may not, while serving as such a member, concurrently
16 hold another office or position in the Government of the
17 United States.
