SALARY DISCLOSURE; EXCEPTION TO REPORT 4 5 ELIMINATION. 6 Section 9 of the Tennessee Valley Authority Act of 1933 (16 U.S.C. 831h) is amended— 8 (1) in subsection (a), by striking "a financial 9 statement" and all that follows through "\$1,500 a year" and inserting "a report of the total number of 10 11 employees at the management level or above, to in-12 clude all executives and board members, that shall 13 include the names, salaries, and duties of such em-14 ployees, that are receiving compensation at or great-15 er than the maximum rate of basic pay for grade 16 GS-15 of the General Schedule"; (2) by striking all that precedes "The Board 17 18 shall" and inserting the following: 19 "SEC. 9. FINANCIAL REPORTING. 20 "(a) Report on Compensation.— "(1) IN GENERAL.—"; and 21 22 (3) in subsection (a), by adding at the end the 23 following:

"(2) Exemption.—The information concerning
