A BILL

To limit the price charged by manufacturers for insulin.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Insulin for All Act
5 of 2023”.

6 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON PRICE OF INSULIN.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
8 sion of law, the price charged by manufacturers of insulin
9 for insulin that is sold in the United States may not exceed
10 \$20 per 1000 units of insulin, which may be contained

1 in one or more vials, pens, cartridges, or other forms of
2 delivery.

3 (b) INSULIN DEFINED.—In this section, the term
4 “insulin” means insulin that is licensed under subsection
5 (a) or (k) of section 351 of the Public Health Service Act
6 (42 U.S.C. 262) and continues to be marketed pursuant
7 to such licensure.

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
