Mr. CURTIS (for himself and Mrs. DINGELL) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To allow additional individuals to enroll in standalone dental plans offered through Federal Exchanges.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Increasing Access to
5 Dental Insurance Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. STANDALONE DENTAL PLANS.**

7 Section 1321 of the Patient Protection and Afford-
8 able Care Act (42 U.S.C. 18041) is amended by adding
9 at the end the following:

1 “(f) AVAILABILITY OF STANDALONE DENTAL
2 PLANS.—The Secretary may not restrict any qualified in-
3 dividual from enrolling in a plan described in section
4 1311(d)(2)(B)(ii) offered through an Exchange estab-
5 lished pursuant to subsection (c) on the basis of such
6 qualified individual not being also enrolled in a qualified
7 health plan offered through the Exchange.”.

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
