## A BILL

To prohibit the Secretary of Transportation from implementing a congestion pricing program until an economic impact analysis is completed and made available to the public, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Economic Impact of  
5 Tolling Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. RESTRICTION ON IMPLEMENTATION OF CONGES-**  
2 **TION PRICING PROGRAM.**

3 The Secretary of Transportation may not implement,  
4 or authorize the implementation of, a congestion pricing  
5 program for any toll road, bridge, or tunnel until the date  
6 on which an economic impact analysis is completed and  
7 such analysis is made available to the public.
