A BILL

To amend the SUPPORT for Patients and Communities Act to provide for immediate eligibility for former foster youth under Medicaid.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Immediate Coverage
5 for Former Foster Youth Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROVIDING FOR IMMEDIATE MEDICAID ELI-**
7 **BILITY FOR FORMER FOSTER YOUTH.**

8 Section 1002(a)(2) of the SUPPORT for Patients
9 and Communities Act (Public Law 115–271) is amended

1 by striking “January 1, 2023” and inserting “the date
2 of enactment of the Immediate Coverage for Former Fos-
3 ter Youth Act”.

4 **SEC. 3. OUTREACH EFFORTS FOR ENROLLMENT OF**
5 **FORMER FOSTER CHILDREN.**

6 Section 1902(a) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
7 1396a(a)) is amended—

8 (1) in paragraph (85), by striking “; and” and
9 inserting a semicolon;

10 (2) in paragraph (86), by striking the period at
11 the end and inserting “; and”; and

12 (3) by inserting after paragraph (86) the fol-
13 lowing new paragraph:

14 “(87) not later than January 1, 2022, establish
15 an outreach and enrollment program, in coordination
16 with the State agency responsible for administering
17 the State plan under part E of title IV and any
18 other appropriate or interested agencies, designed to
19 increase the enrollment of individuals who are eligi-
20 ble for medical assistance under the State plan
21 under paragraph (10)(A)(i)(IX) in accordance with
22 best practices established by the Secretary.”.

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
