## A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to require an Inspector General investigation of allegations of retaliatory personnel actions taken in response to making protected communications regarding sexual assault.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. INSPECTOR GENERAL INVESTIGATION OF AL-**  
2 **LEGATIONS OF RETALIATORY PERSONNEL**  
3 **ACTIONS TAKEN IN RESPONSE TO MAKING**  
4 **PROTECTED COMMUNICATIONS REGARDING**  
5 **SEXUAL ASSAULT.**

6 Section 1034(c)(2)(A) of title 10, United States  
7 Code, is amended by striking “sexual harassment or” and  
8 inserting “rape, sexual assault, or other sexual misconduct  
9 in violation of sections 920 through 920c of this title (arti-  
10 cles 120 through 120c of the Uniform Code of Military  
11 Justice), sexual harassment, or”.
