A BILL

To amend the Deficit Reduction Act of 2005 to make permanent the Money Follows the Person Rebalancing Demonstration.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT EXTENSION OF MONEY FOLLOWS**
4 **THE PERSON REBALANCING DEMONSTRA-**
5 **TION.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 6071(h) of the Deficit Re-
7 duction Act of 2005 (42 U.S.C. 1396a note) is amended—

8 (1) in paragraph (1)—

9 (A) in subparagraph (I), by inserting

10 “and” after the semicolon;

1 (B) by amending subparagraph (J) to read
2 as follows:

3 “(G) \$450,000,000 for each fiscal year
4 after fiscal year 2021.”; and

5 (C) by striking subparagraph (K); and

6 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “September
7 30, 2023” and inserting “September 30 of such fis-
8 cal year”.

9 (b) REDISTRIBUTION OF UNEXPENDED GRANT
10 AWARDS.—Section 6701(e)(2) of the Deficit Reduction
11 Act of 2005 (42 U.S.C. 1396a note) is amended by adding
12 at the end the following new sentence: “Any portion of
13 a State grant award for a fiscal year under this section
14 that is unexpended by the State at the end of the fourth
15 succeeding fiscal year shall be rescinded by the Secretary
16 and added to the appropriation for the fifth succeeding
17 fiscal year.”.
