To repeal titles I and II of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL.**

4 Titles I and II of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Re-
5 form and Consumer Protection Act (12 U.S.C. 5301 et
6 seq.) are hereby repealed, and the provisions of law
7 amended or repealed by such titles are restored or revived
8 as if such titles had not been enacted.
