## A BILL

To amend title VIII of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to require the Secretary of Education to complete payments under such title to local educational agencies eligible for such payments within 3 fiscal years.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Impact Aid Timely  
5 Repayment Act of 2011”.

1 **SEC. 2. TIMELY PAYMENTS.**

2 Section 8010 of the Elementary and Secondary Edu-  
3 cation Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7710) is amended by add-  
4 ing at the end the following:

5 “(d) TIMELY PAYMENTS.—

6 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Subject to paragraph (2),  
7 the Secretary shall pay a local educational agency  
8 the full amount that the agency is eligible to receive  
9 under this title for a fiscal year not later than Sep-  
10 tember 30 of the second fiscal year following the fis-  
11 cal year for which such amount has been appro-  
12 priated if, not later than 1 calendar year following  
13 the fiscal year in which such amount has been ap-  
14 propriated, such local educational agency submits to  
15 the Secretary all the data and information necessary  
16 for the Secretary to pay the full amount that the  
17 agency is eligible to receive under this title for such  
18 fiscal year.

19 “(2) PAYMENTS WITH RESPECT TO FISCAL  
20 YEARS IN WHICH INSUFFICIENT FUNDS ARE APPRO-  
21 PRIATED.—For a fiscal year in which the amount  
22 appropriated under section 8014 is insufficient to  
23 pay the full amount a local educational agency is eli-  
24 gible to receive under this title, paragraph (1) shall  
25 be applied by substituting ‘is available to pay the

1       agency' for 'the agency is eligible to receive' each  
2       place it appears.”.
