# **A BILL**

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to install in the area of the World War II Memorial in the District of Columbia a suitable plaque or an inscription with the words that President Franklin D. Roosevelt prayed with the United States on June 6, 1944, the morning of D-Day.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        *This Act may be cited as the “World War II Memorial*  
5 *Prayer Act of 2014”.*

6 **SEC. 2. PLACEMENT OF PLAQUE OR INSCRIPTION AT**  
7 **WORLD WAR II MEMORIAL.**

8        *The Secretary of the Interior—*

9            *(1) shall install in the area of the World War II*  
10 *Memorial in the District of Columbia a suitable*  
11 *plaque or an inscription with the words that Presi-*  
12 *dent Franklin D. Roosevelt prayed with the United*  
13 *States on June 6, 1944, the morning of D-Day;*

14            *(2) shall design, procure, prepare, and install the*  
15 *plaque or inscription referred to in paragraph (1);*  
16 *and*

17            *(3) may not use Federal funds to prepare or in-*  
18 *stall the plaque or inscription referred to in para-*  
19 *graph (1), but may accept and expend private con-*  
20 *tributions for this purpose.*

21 **SEC. 3. COMMEMORATIVE WORKS ACT.**

22        *Chapter 89 of title 40, United States Code (commonly*  
23 *known as the “Commemorative Works Act”), shall apply*  
24 *to the design and placement of the plaque within the area*  
25 *of the World War II Memorial.*
