A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Defense to establish an electronic means by which members of the Ready Reserves of the Armed Forces may track their active-duty service.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELECTRONIC TRACKING OF CERTAIN RESERVE**

4 **DUTY.**

5 The Secretary of Defense shall establish an electronic
6 means by which members of the Ready Reserve of the
7 Armed Forces can track their operational active-duty serv-
8 ice performed after January 28, 2008, under section
9 12301(a), 12301(d), 12301(g), 12302, or 12304 of title

1 10, United States Code. The tour calculator shall specify
2 early retirement credit authorized for each qualifying tour
3 of active duty, as well as cumulative early reserve retire-
4 ment credit authorized to date under section 12731(f) of
5 such title.
