3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Ensuring Successful
5 Reentry Act of 2019”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT THAT PRISONERS ON WORK RE-**
2 **LEASE PAY PART OF THEIR GROSS INCOME**
3 **OVER FOR HOUSING.**

4 Section 3622(c) of title 18, United States Code, is
5 amended by striking all that follows after “facility if” and
6 inserting the following: “the rates of pay and other condi-
7 tions of employment will not be less than those paid or
8 provided for work of a similar nature in the community.”.
