A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “90-Day Review Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. LIMITATIONS ON CLAIMS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 139(l) of title 23, United
7 States Code, is amended by striking “150 days” each
8 place it appears and inserting “90 days”.

1 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—

2 (1) Section 330(e) of title 23, United States
3 Code, is amended—

4 (A) in paragraph (2)(A), by striking “150
5 days” and inserting “90 days”; and

6 (B) in paragraph (3)(B)(i), by striking
7 “150 days” and inserting “90 days”.

8 (2) Section 24201(a)(4) of title 49, United
9 States Code, is amended by striking “of 150 days”.
