A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Homeland Security to submit a report to Congress on security screening by the Transportation Security Administration of veterans and other passengers with amputations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Screening Amputees
5 and Veterans with Efficiency and Dignity Act” or the
6 “Save Dignity Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPORT ON TSA SCREENING OF VETERANS AND**
2 **OTHER PASSENGERS WITH PROSTHESES.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Homeland Secu-
4 rity shall submit a report to Congress by not later than
5 6 months after the date of the enactment of this Act on
6 security screening by the Transportation Security Admin-
7 istration of veterans and other passengers with amputa-
8 tions, with or without prosthesis.

9 (b) CONTENTS.—The report shall include analysis
10 of—

11 (1) the disparities that exist between airports in
12 the screening of such passengers;

13 (2) identification of the airports at which the
14 Administration uses procedures and methods for
15 such screening that are efficient, safe, timely, and
16 respectful of such passengers, and airports at which
17 the Administration does not use such procedures
18 and methods; and

19 (3) description of actions that will be taken by
20 the Administration to implement such procedures
21 and methods at all airports at which the Administra-
22 tion performs security screening of passengers.

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
